Customer Real Estate Photography Preparation Checklist

General Home Preparation

- Clean thoroughly (vacuum, dust, mop, wipe countertops)
- Declutter every room (remove excess decor, personal items, toys)
- Arrange furniture neatly (fluff pillows, straighten chairs, tuck in chairs under tables)
- Clean windows (inside and out if possible)
- Add simple decor (fresh flowers, bowls of fruit, tasteful centerpieces)
- Open all interior doors for a spacious look

Lighting & Ambience

- Turn on all lights (lamps, ceiling lights, under-cabinet lights)
- Open blinds/curtains to let in natural light
- Turn on fireplaces if possible
- Turn off ceiling fans and TVs during photography

Kitchen

- Clear countertops (remove dishes, mail, paper towels, cleaning supplies)
- Wipe down surfaces and shine stainless steel appliances
- Remove fridge magnets, calendars, and notes
- Place a bowl of fresh fruit or flowers for a pop of color

Bathrooms

- Close toilet lids
- Remove personal items (toothbrushes, razors, shampoo bottles)
- Hang fresh, neatly folded towels
- Clean mirrors, faucets, and glass shower doors

Bedrooms

- Make all beds with wrinkle-free bedding
- Remove excess items from nightstands and dressers
- Hide laundry hampers and personal clothing
- Open blinds and arrange pillows neatly

Living & Dining Areas

- Arrange furniture to maximize open space
- Hide cords, remotes, and electronics when possible

■ Set dining table with minimal, tasteful place settings or a centerpiece

Exterior

- Mow lawn, trim bushes, remove weeds
- Sweep walkways, porches, and driveways
- Remove cars from driveway and in front of the house
- Put away hoses, trash cans, garden tools, and toys
- Add potted plants or flowers for curb appeal

Final Touches Before Photographer Arrives

- Walk through every room to ensure it's photo-ready
- Remove pets (and their beds, bowls, litter boxes) from visible areas
- Double-check all lights are on and blinds are open
- Make sure there's no one in mirrors or reflective surfaces
